Since 1881, the Philadelphia Charity Ball has been dedicated to introducing the brightest youths of Philadelphia to the rewards of philanthropy and volunteerism. The Ball is a formal celebration that has raised millions of dollars over the years for many worthwhile charities. Each year, the Ball endeavors to expand and continue this tradition by inviting young ladies to participate as Debutantes and young gentlemen to join the Young Gentlemen's Committee. We hope that you will choose to make the commitment to support our beneficiary, Special Olympics Pennsylvania, by participating as a Debutante or Young Gentlemen's Committee member at the 2024 Philadelphia Charity Ball.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A PARTICIPANT?

- 1. All participants will assist throughout the year in carrying out the Ball's mission to raise funds for non-profit organizations and making philanthropy a central part of their lives.
- 2. We ask for all participants to submit names of friends and family to invite to the Ball as well as names of their peers who may also want to participate as a Debutante or Young Gentleman.
- 3. The formal name of each participant will appear on the official Ball invitation to be sent out in the fall.
- 4. Each Debutante will submit a formal photo and brief biography which will be featured on their dedicated full page in the program book. Each Young Gentleman will submit a formal photo and brief biography which will be featured on their dedicated half page in the program book.
- 5. A sponsor may be submitted to cover the Debutante's or Young Gentleman's donation and would be recognized on the participant's page.
- 6. We encourage each participant to continuously engage in volunteering and philanthropy and submit photos to feature on the program book's Volunteer Page. This is an opportunity for us to showcase the many wonderful ways our participants contribute to charities throughout the year.

ABOUT THE BALL

The year culminates with the Ball on Friday, November 29^{th} . It is an evening of festive dining and dancing to great music by the Renaissance Orchestra while generously supporting our beneficiary, Special Olympics Pennsylvania.

Debutantes and their mothers (or special guests) will receive guests upon entering the Ballroom.

A Debutante's father (or presenter of her choice) will present her to the Board of Directors in a formal presentation after dinner. The Debutantes will then grace the dance floor with their fathers (or presenters) for the Debutante Waltz.

Members of The Young Gentlemen's Committee will serve as escorts for the Debutantes throughout the evening. They will be introduced and participate in the presentation ceremony then dance with the Debutantes for the Commencement Waltz.

EVENT ATTIRE

The Ball is a formal event. Debutantes will wear a long white evening dress, opera length white gloves, and an optional hair ornament. The Board of Directors will provide them with bouquets.

Young Gentlemen will wear white tie and tails with white gloves. The Board of Directors will provide them with boutonnières.

THE REHEARSAL

The week prior to the Ball, a rehearsal will take place for all Debutantes, fathers (or chosen presenters) and Young Gentlemen's Committee participants (information to follow.)
